How to fix an issue

How to fix an issue (summary)

- 1. clone repo and build it
- 2. run your own version and reproduce the bug
- 3. explore the project
- 4. fix the bug
- 5. create branch with modifications
- 6. push to your fork

How to create a pull request

How to create a pull request (summary)

- 1. create pull request
- 2. address requests for modifications
- 3. udpate pull request / merge main
- 4. repeat until merged

Contributing is not a one-way street

- Maintainers review your code and suggest improvements
- Maintainers are committing to support and evolve your code
- If it breaks, it's their problem, not yours
- If it makes creating new features hard, it's their problem, not yours

Pull Requests are an exchange of value and responsability between contributors and maintainers

Option or parameter available to allow eg mirror, or copy mode.


